## Code of Conduct – Playing Members

All playing members are requested to abide by the following values:

1. Players **are expected to** arrive 1 hour before the start of the match (and be at the ground 30 minutes before away games), in order to help prepare the ground and themselves for the game.
2. At home games, players **must** select and do a match day job. The match day job list is in the home dressing room.
3. Players **must** abide by the ECB - One Game - Code of Conduct. Most notably, respecting the opposition, umpires and all people involved in cricket. A copy of the ECB -One Game - Code of Conduct is displayed in the club house.
4. Players **must** assist with putting the ground covers on during and after home games, as required.
5. Where officials are not provided for a game, players **must** assist with umpiring and/or scoring, as required.
6. Players **must** pay due match fees immediately after the game.
7. Players **are expected to** socialise with the team and opposition for at least 30 minutes after the game, or explain to the captain why this is not possible.
8. Players **must** let the captain know their availability for the next game immediately after the current game, or earlier.
9. Players **must** contact the captain in person or by telephone (**not** using text message, email or Teamer) if they wish to drop out of a game they have been selected for. It should be exceptional to drop out of a game you have been selected for, and very exceptional to drop out with less than 48 hours' notice.
10. Players **are expected to** support the club through supporting social events and assisting in the working parties.
