



# COVID -19 NETS RULES

In order for Farnham Royal Cricket Club to open our facilities for training purposes we need to implement and enforce a number of rules, as set out by the Government. Any member wishing to use the nets for practice must abide by these rules and the accompanying booking T's & C's. Any infringement may result in you being asked to leave the ground and immediate termination of membership.

1. If you, or anyone in your household, has been suffering from the symptoms of COVID-19 you **MUST NOT** use any of the FRCC facilities and must stay at home. A full list of symptoms can be found at [www.gov.uk/coronavirus](http://www.gov.uk/coronavirus) but the main ones are a high temperature, a new, continuous cough, a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste
2. The Nets and training facilities are only available to paid up members of FRCC
3. Nets sessions **MUST** be booked online and confirmed in advance. For booking information see our website [www.frcc.info](http://www.frcc.info)
4. **ALL** players **MUST** wear appropriate safety equipment including helmet, gloves and pads when batting
5. Under 18's **MUST** be accompanied by an adult from the same household
6. A **MAXIMUM** of 6 players from different households may practice at any one time.
7. Players must use their own equipment and not share. Only the bowler should touch the ball
8. No sweat or saliva must come in to contact with the ball or other players or their equipment.
9. Players must wash their hands before coming to FRCC and as soon as they return home. Players are advised to bring, and use, hand sanitiser regularly during their time at FRCC

10. Respect social distancing between yourself, other users and grounds staff. Keep at least 2m between yourself and anyone not from your household.
11. Please do not use FRCC facilities for meeting and socialising before or after your session. There is enough time left between bookings for you to tidy up and leave before the next booking arrives.
12. Respect and follow any instruction given by the Club Representative or Ground Staff present at your session
13. Take all your rubbish home with you.
14. Check the facilities before use and report any damage to Brian Pace.
15. There are no Clubhouse, toilet or first aid facilities available at FRCC. You use the outdoor facilities at your own risk and are advised to bring your own first aid kit.
16. In an Emergency, the closest A&E department is at Wexham Park Hospital, Slough SL2 4HL.
